ACEC-SC Service to the Profession
ACEC-SC Public Service Award

Eligibility:

ACEC-SC Service to the Profession – This recognition is for principals and employees of ACEC-SC member firms. The nominee may have worked hard to further ACEC-SC goals by serving on state and/or national committees, and boards. The nominee may have represented the engineering profession on boards or commissions outside ACEC-SC or the engineering community.

ACEC-SC Public Service Award – This recognition may be for either principals or employees of ACEC-SC member firms who have distinguished themselves in their communities or in the state by serving on public boards or commissions. This award also may be conferred upon individuals who have served as career public employees at the local, state or national level. Further, ACEC-SC may recognize a person who has served in a political office.

Requirements:

ACEC-SC Service to the Profession – Nominee must be a principal or employee of an ACEC-SC member firm. Nominees should have academic and professional qualifications and accomplishments demonstrating notable contributions to the objectives of ACEC-SC and may include: being a principal for no less than 5 years of a firm which has been an ACEC member firm for no less than 5 years, service as an ACEC-SC officer, director or active committee member. Other considerations include the nominee's education, registration and professional experience. The nominee should be well respected inside and outside the engineering community. The nominee should be perceived in his or her community as a leader. The nominee should be one who represents ACEC-SC well. Service to the Profession recipients may be nominated to ACEC for its recognition programs. **Deadline for nominations is March 31, 2008.**

ACEC-SC Public Service Award – The nominee shall be an outstanding individual who has been involved in community service such as boards, commissions or community groups and has demonstrated a sustained commitment to the community. The nominee should be perceived by the public in his or her community as a leader. The nominee should have been active in local, county or state government. **Deadline for nominations is March 31, 2008.**
