Supplemental Guidance for ACEC-SC 2012-2013 Scholarship

2. Completed applications are to be submitted to the designated contact person at the student's school, who in turn will have the applications pre-screened for completeness and will submit the qualifying candidates to the ACEC-SC Scholarship Committee Chairman at the address below.
3. The student or the university's contact person will attach an official grade transcript to the application.
4. Students should request the individual completing the required Recommendation Form to send it directly to:

5. Unless otherwise required by the university, ACEC-SC will implement the scholarship by depositing \$3,500 at the student's university in a university-administered account designated for the exclusive benefit of the awardee, for direct payment or reimbursement of education-related expenditures.
6. In the event the selected recipient of ACEC-SC's scholarship fails to enroll or meet the qualifying criteria in the Fall of 2012, ACEC-SC will redirect the funds to the highest-ranked back-up candidate.
7. This scholarship is limited to full time BS engineering curriculum students who will be entering their third, fourth or fifth year in the Fall of 2012.
8. Deadlines – All applications, including transcripts and recommendation forms must be received by stated deadlines. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

All Application Forms and corresponding transcripts shall be received by March 9, 2012.
